A BY-LAW TO APPOINT AN INTEGRITY COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS Section 223.2 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25*, as amended, authorizes a municipality to appoint an Integrity Commissioner who is responsible for acting in an independent manner to apply the code of conduct of council and local boards and such other duties as may be assigned to them by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Magnetawan issued a Request for Proposal on behalf of the 10 Almaguin Municipalities seeking the services of an Integrity Commissioner and received proposals from

- ADR Chambers Inc;
- Expertise for Municipalities (E4m);
- Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP;
- John DaRe, Barrister & Solicitor; and
- Weaver Simmons LLP.

AND WHEREAS the 10 Almaguin Clerks appointed an Evaluation Committee to evaluate the proposals, with the proposal from ADR Chambers Inc. receiving the highest combined score based on the evaluation criteria as detailed in the Request for Proposal document;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STRONG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Request for Proposals for an Integrity Commissioner be awarded to ADR Chambers Inc;
- 2. THAT Michael Maynard of ADRC is hereby appointed Integrity Commissioner for the Township of Strong;
- 3. THAT the Corporation of the Township of Strong is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with ADR Chambers Inc., herein referred to as ADRC, to provide Integrity Commissioner Services to the Township, attached hereto as Schedule A and forming part of this By-law;
- 4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk Administrator are hereby authorized to execute this agreement on behalf of the Corporation.
- 5. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and effect on the date of its passing.
- 6. THAT By-law 2018-036 is hereby repealed.
